| <i>Does he eat lunch at noon?</i> | <i>What time does he have dinner?</i> | <i>Verey day at ninght</i> |
| <i>No, he eats lunch at one o'clock</i> | <i>at eight o'clock.</i> | |
| <i>Do they take the bus to class?</i> | <i>When do they take the subway?</i> | |
