the present continuous is the present of be + verb+ing:
it's raining.

she's wearing shoes

AFFIRMATIVE

S + TO BE (EN PRESENTE)+ ING
I AM PLAYING
HE IS PLAYING
THEY ARE PLAYING



NEGATIVE

S+ TO BE (EN PRESENTE NEG)+ ING
I AM NOT PLAYING
HE ISN'T PLAYING
THEY AREN'T PLAYING

INTERROGAION

IS SHE READING A BOOK?



PRESENT CONTINUOUS YES/NO QUESTIONS

ARE YOU WEARING GLOVES? YES, I AM. NO, I AM NOT
IS SHE WEARING BOOTS? YES, SHE IS. NO SHE'S NOT
ARE THEY WEARING SUNGLASSES? YES, THEY ARE. NO, THEY'RE NOT
