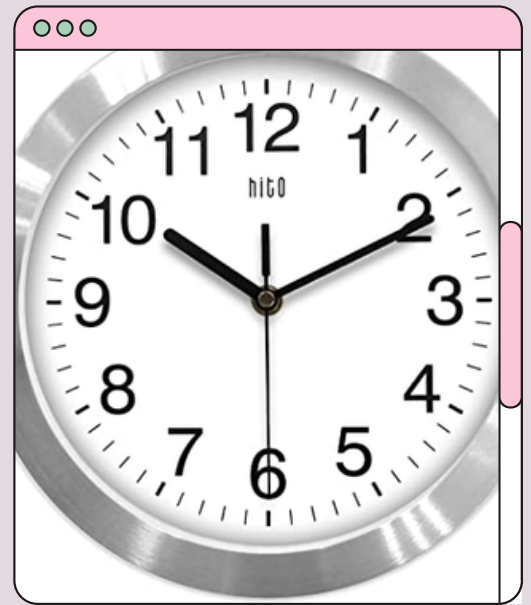

Wh-questions

WH questions in English. WH questions are those that begin with interrogative pronouns whose first two letters are precisely wh (except How), for example, who, what, when, etc. They are used to obtain information about a place, the name of a person, a time or day, or the reason for something.



Wh-questions ejemplo

What? = ¿Qué? What is that? = ¿Qué es eso?
 Where? = ¿Dónde?
 Where is her house? = ¿Dónde es su casa?
 Which? = ¿Cuál?
 Which is your notebook? = ¿Cuál es tu cuaderno?
 Why? = ¿Por qué?
 Why are you awake? = ¿Por qué estás despierto?

WHERE PLACE	WHY REASON	HOW WAY SOMETHING IS DONE



Present continuous

It refers to situations or actions that are being carried out at the moment and, as in Spanish, learning this tense is essential to have fluency and expression in any conversation in English.

present continuous examples

Am I singing in the rain? Are you singing in the rain? Are you singing in the rain? Is it singing in the rain?

can't talk. I'm brushing my teeth.
 can talk now. He's having a shower.

ACTIONS IN PROGRESS AROUND NOW

is reading a new book. I love it!
 is training hard these days.

SIGNAL WORDS

at the moment, these days, this week, this month, etc.

DRINK REGULARLY I'M DOING IT NOW
 drink tea. I'm drinking tea.
