
AFFIRMATIVE

But i/you/we/they walk to school

NEGATIVE

He/she/itdoesn't = does not l/you/we/theydon't = do not





EXAMPLE

AFFIRMATIVE

He Works near here downtown

We **live** with our parents

They **use** public transportation

NEGATIVE

He doesn't work

we don't live alone

they don't need a car



DO i/you/we/they get up early?

DOES he/she/it get up early?

Don't add —s tp the verb: does she live alone? (NOT: does she lives alone?)
