AFFIRMATIVE

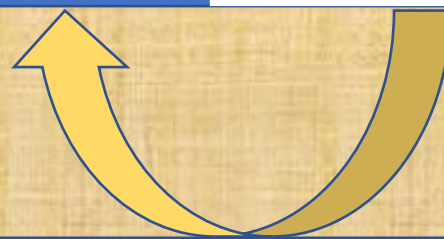
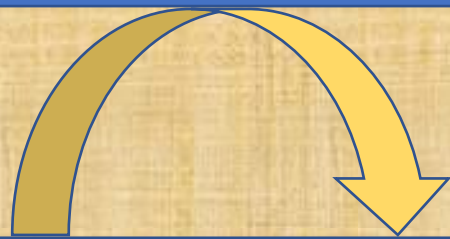
Verbs with he/she/it and in –s: he/she to **walks** to school

We **live** with our parents

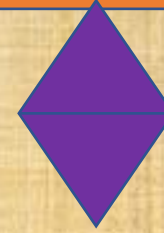
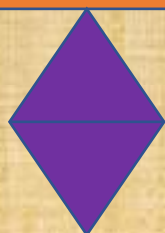
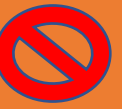
They **use** public transportation
