Rachel: Where on Diane street?

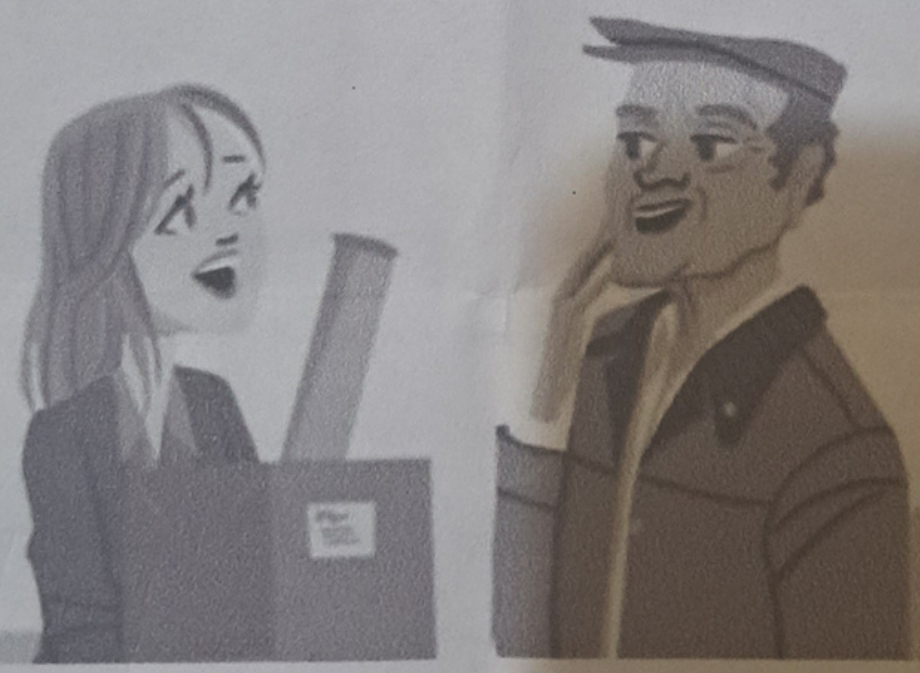
Man: It's on the corner of Diane Street and Seventh Avenue.

Imagine you're going to have a party. Complete the invitation. Then draw a map and write directions to the party in your school.

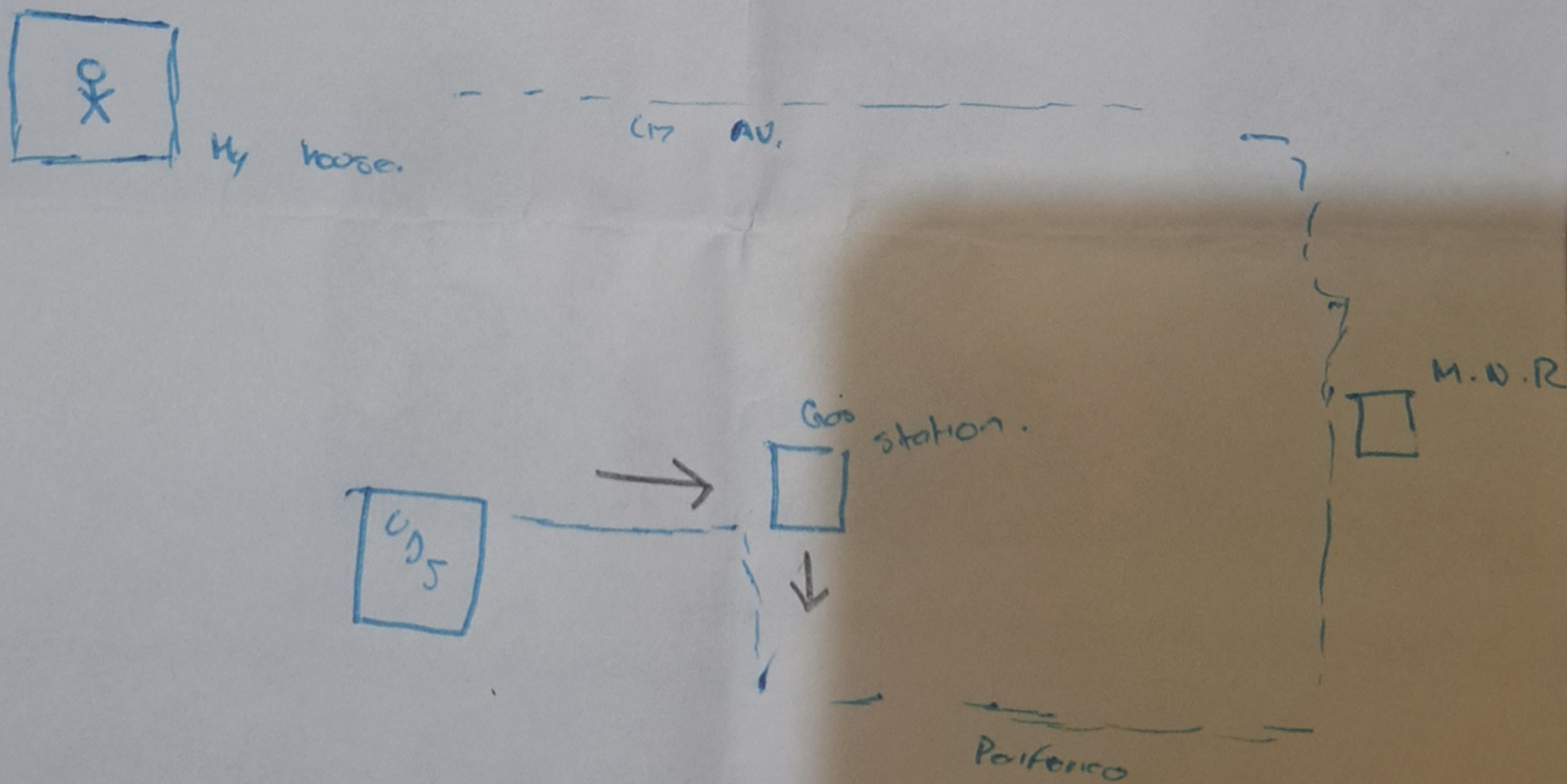


Map to the party
