Man: You're welcome.

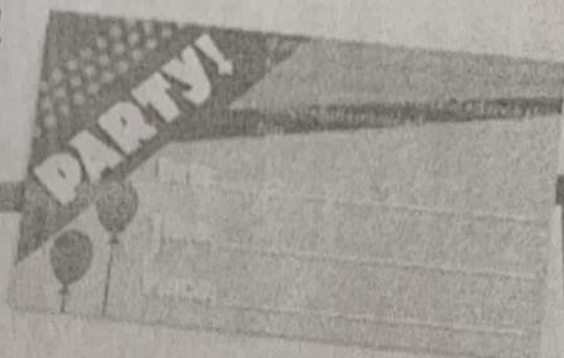

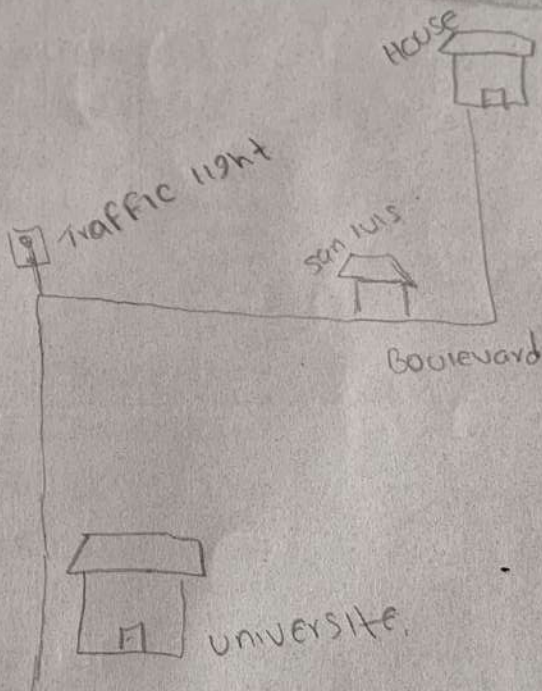
