NEGATIVE AUXILIAR IN PAST.

Did not = Didn't



The negative form of the simple past in English could not be simpler: you simply have to put didn't in front of the main verb, which remains in the infinitive. Also, it doesn't apply to all grammatical people, it never changes!

Didn't is the contraction of did not. You won't find yourself not very often, except in writing or when you want to emphasize something.

STRUCTURE

Subject + did not (didn't) + verb + complement

1. She didn't eat soup.



1. Eliseo didn't play baseball last sunday.



1. They didn't go to the park yesterday.



1. Brenda didn't eat pizza.



1. He didn't drink water last night



1. She didn't cry in her room yesterday



1. Leo didn't dance at the party last night



1. Oberth didn't eat with his mom three hours ago



- **Oberth didn't drink tequila last night**



- **The dog did not play in park yesterday afternoon**

- **luis didn't ruun in the morning**



- **Alex didn't play video games an hour ago**
