


NEGATIVE SENTENCES IN THE PAST TENSE

Mario did not breakfast yesterday












Kember didn't throw a party last night







Pizza did not have cheese last night



The cat did not drink milk in the morning



Rose did not go out to the park yesterday

The teacher did not get to teach last week



The masons did not work yesterday



Mark did not go to school on Monday



Deni did not take food to the cinema yesterday



Alonso did not take his colors to school yesterday

Cristian did not arrive at the bowling on Wednesday

Lizeth did not go to dance practices on Saturday





The horse did not eat grass yesterday



Wendy did not bring pencil yesterday

Javier did not go to the Olympics a year ago

The teacher did not bring the exams on Friday

Sentences in the simple past are composed of a subject, a verb in the past tense, and a complement.

However in negative sentences in the simple past the auxiliary "did" is added followed by the word "not" and then the verb is occupied in its natural form.

The past tense of negative sentences is formed by writing did before the verb, and then we write not. The verb is written in its simple form for regular verbs and for irregular verbs. The use of contraction didn't (did not) is common. You didn't work very hard last week.
