A: Good idea. Do we have any meat?

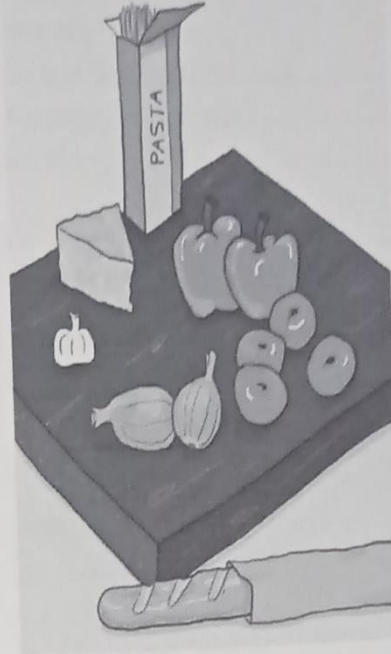
B: Well, we have any beef, but I don't want any meat in the sauce. Let's get some tomatoes and onions.

A: That sounds good. Do you have some eggs or meat?

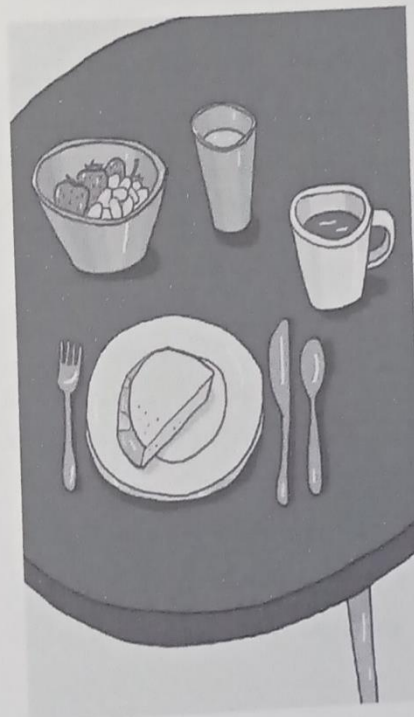
B: No, I don't eat some eggs or meat in the morning.

B: Well, I usually have any bread, but I don't put any butter on it.

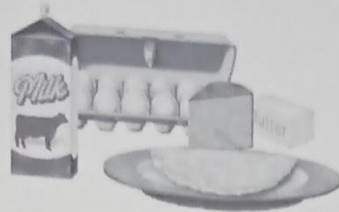

B: I always have any juice and coffee. I don't put any sugar in my coffee, but I like any milk in it.



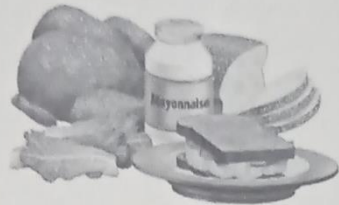
