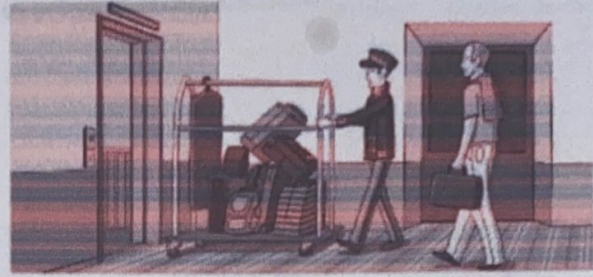

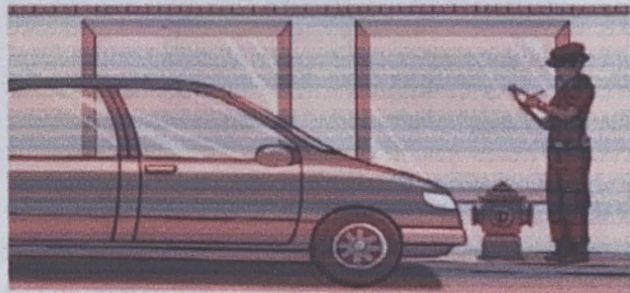

 B: Yeah, but let's get any bread. And some cheese, too.

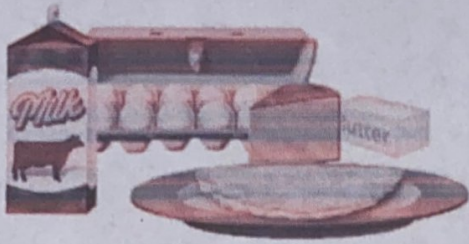


2. A: What do you eat for breakfast?

 B: I always have any juice and coffee. I don't put some sugar in my coffee, but I like any milk in it.



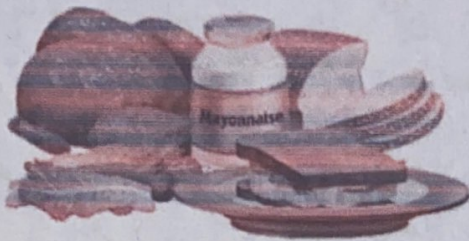

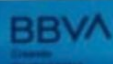
