 B: Yeah, but let's get SOME bread. And SOME cheese, too.

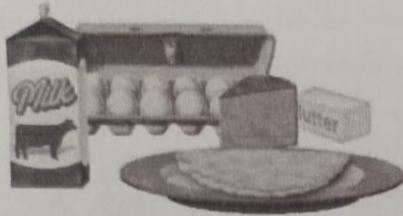

 B: I always have Some juice and coffee. I don't put any sugar in my coffee, but I like Some milk in it.



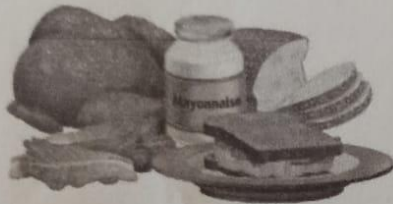
