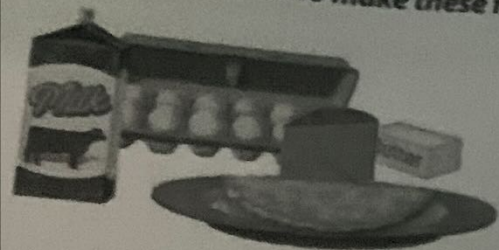
1. A: What do you want for dinner?

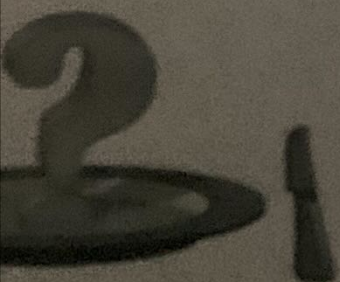
