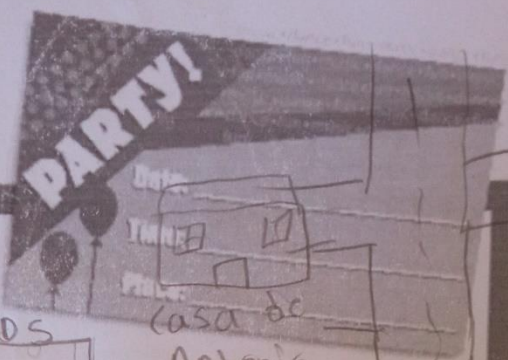

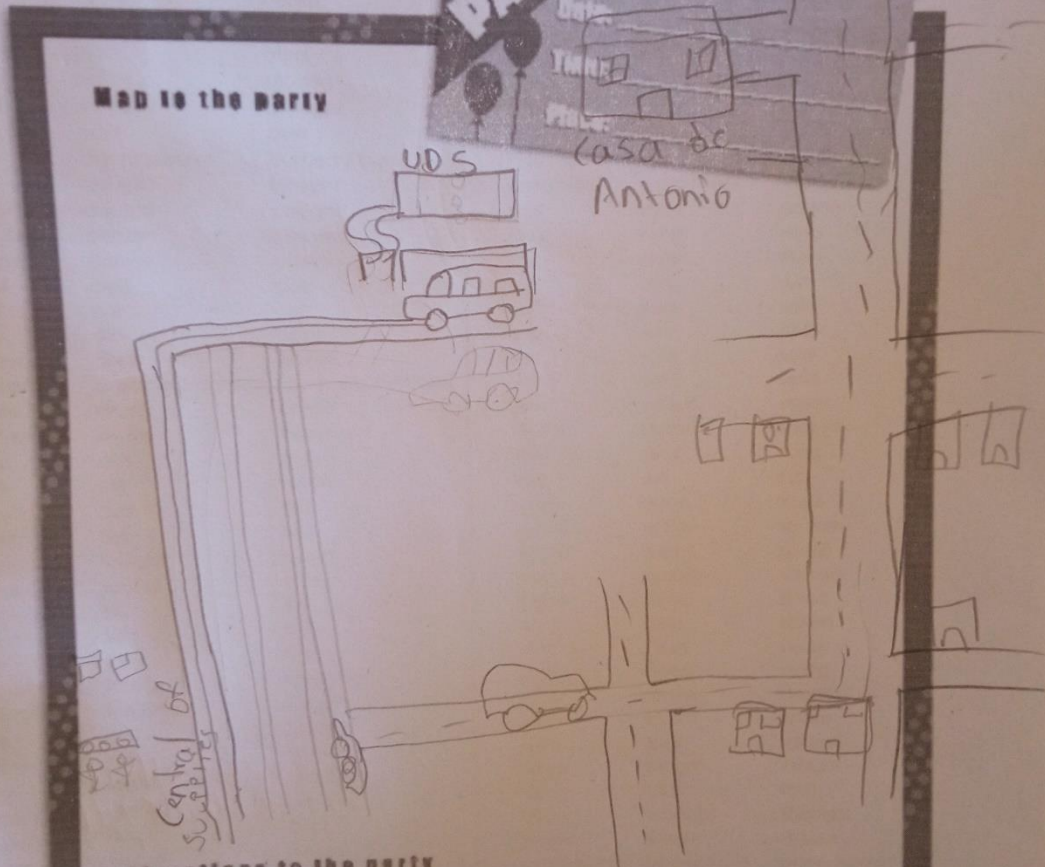

Map to the party



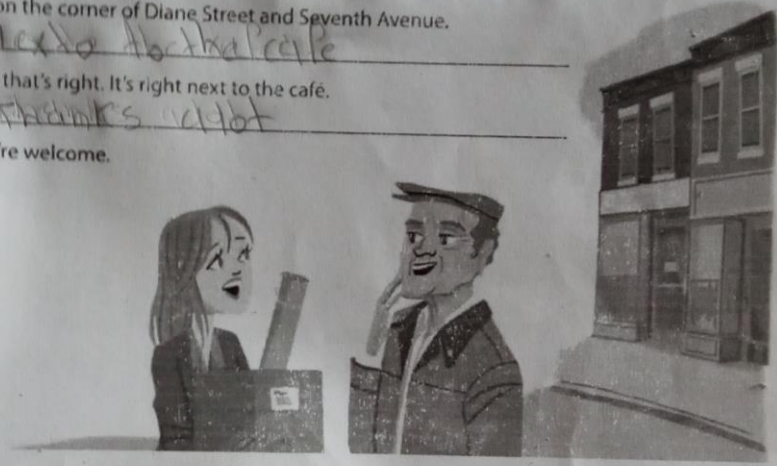
Directions to the party
