 B: Yeah, but let's get some bread. And any cheese, too.

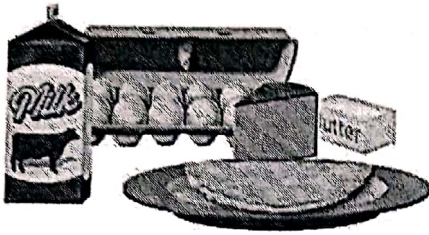
