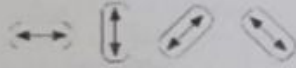

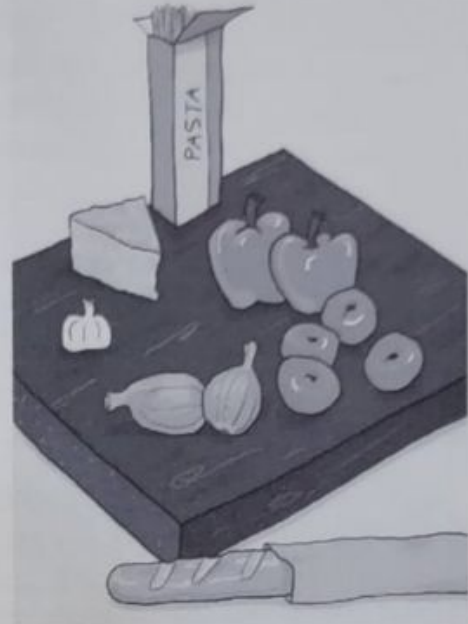

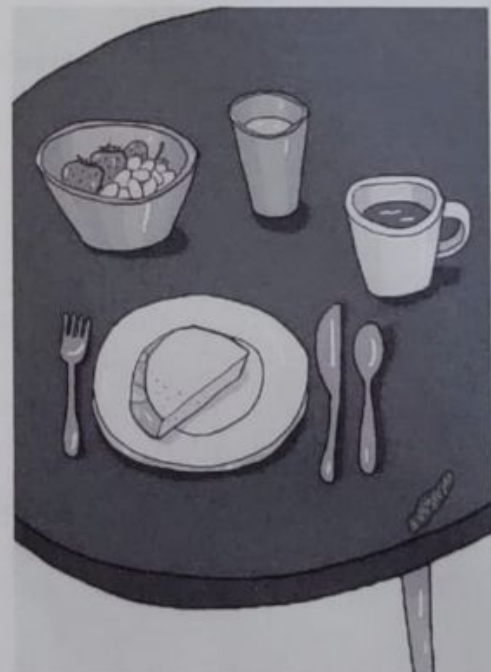

 B: Yeah, but let's get some bread. And some cheese, too.

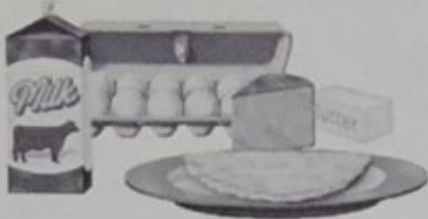


2. A: What do you eat for breakfast?
