A: Good idea. Do we have any meat?


B: Well, we have some beef, but I don't want any meat in the sauce. Let's get some tomatoes and onions.

A: That sounds good. Do you have some eggs or meat?


B: No, I don't eat any eggs or meat in the morning.

A: Really? Do you have anything else?


B: Well, I usually have some bread, but I don't put any butter on it.


