## AFIRMATIVES

Structure: Subject + to be + going to + infinitive + complement

- 1. I am going to drive a motorcycle in the desert
- 2. You are going to clean the kitchen today
- 3. He is going to play "Minecraft" with your friends.

## **NEGATIVES**

Structure: Subject + to be + not/n't + going to + infinitive + complement

- 1. I am not going to cook the picnic food tomorrow
- 2. We are not going to plan the strategy in the game
- 3. It is not going to work in extreme conditions.

## **INTERROGATIVES**

Structure, Question: To be + subject + going to + infinitive + complement +?

Structure, Answer: Yes, + Subject + to be Structure, Answer: No, + Subject + to be +

not/n't
