PAST SIMPLE

AFIRMATIVES

Structure: Subject + verb (past simple) + complement.

1. I ran in the street this morning.
2. You walked in the park with your son.
3. He awoke too late yesterday.

NEGATIVES

Structure: Subject + didn't + infinitive verb + complement.

1. I didn't build the family factory.
2. We didn't eat in the mall the last week.
3. It didn't work very fast in the job.

INTERROGATIVES

Structure, Question: Did + subject + infinitive + complement + ?.

Structure, Answer: Yes, + Subject + did.

Structure, Answer: No, + Subject + did + not/n't

1. Did they write the class notes today? No, they didn't.
2. Is she search a trainer this afternoon? Yes, she did.
