FUTURO "BE GOING TO"

Podemos usar "be going to" para transmitir una idea de futuro.

Afirmativo

Sujeto + (be) going to

I'm going to

Voy a

I am going to see you tomorrow. (Yo voy a verte mañana)

+ infinitivo

Go to the beach this weekend.

Ir a la playa este fin de semana.

Sujeto + (be) going to

She's going to

Va a

He is going to visit her next week. (Él la va a visitar la siguiente semana)

+ infinitivo

Have spaghetti for dinner tonight.

Cenar espagueti esta noche.

Sujeto + (be) going to

They're going to

Van a

You are going to study to be a lawyer. (Tú vas a estudiar para ser un abogado)

+ infinitivo

Release a new album next year.

Lanzar un nuevo álbum el año que viene.

Negativo

Sujeto + (be) going to

I'm not going to

No voy a

I think I am not going to be sick

+ infinitivo

Study medicine anymore - it's too hard!

Seguir estudiando medicina. ¡Es demasiado difícil!

Sujeto + (be) going to

He's not going to

No va a

We are not going to travel by plane

+ infinitivo

Listen to what you say.

Escuchar lo que le digas.

Sujeto + (be) going to

We're not going to

No vamos a

It is not going to rain

+ infinitivo

Go to the wedding because we have to work.

Ir a la boda porque tenemos que trabajar.

Interrogativo

Sujeto + (be) going to

Am I going to

¿Voy a

Are they going to eat out tonight? (¿Ellos van a comer fuera esta noche?)

+ infinitivo

Finish the project on time?

Terminar el proyecto a tiempo?

Sujeto + (be) going to

Are you going to

¿Vas a

Is she going to leave for Europe on Monday? (¿Ella va a partir a Europa el lunes?)

+ infinitivo

Come to the party on Sunday?

Venir a la fiesta el domingo?
