Mindy: So where were you last year?

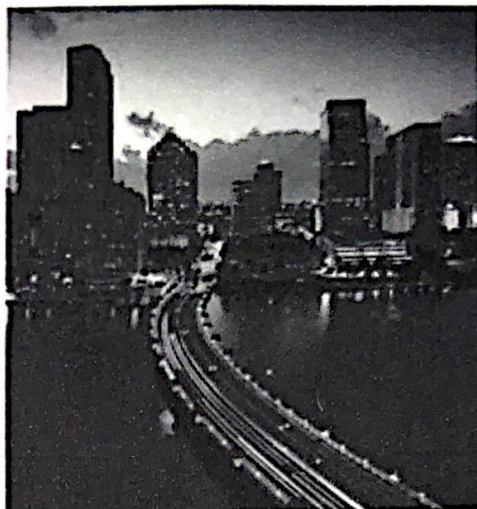
Alan: I was in Japan.

Alan: No, I wasn't. I was in Osaka. I had a job there.


