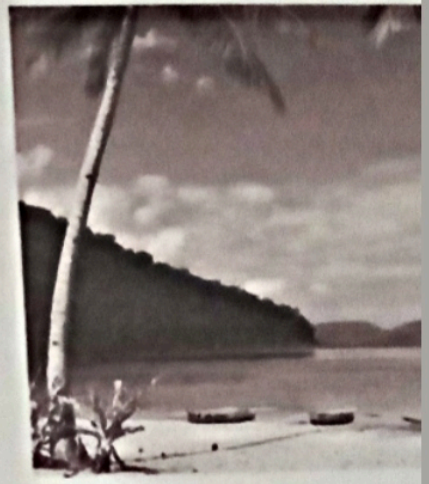
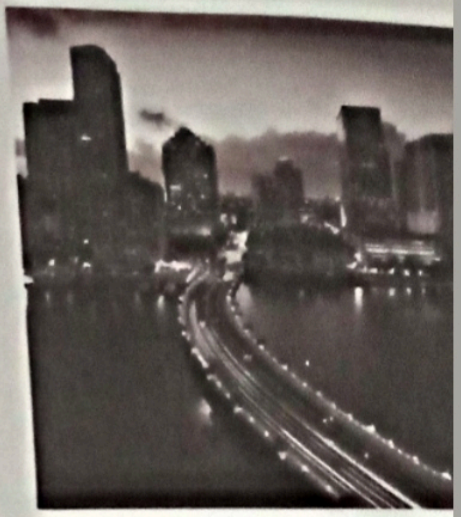

**Jennifer:** No, they weren't. I was with my sister. It was great!

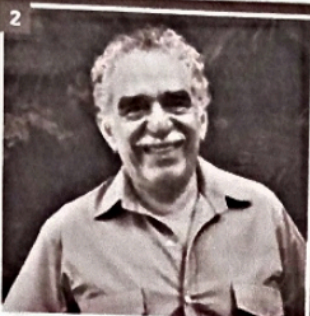

**Alan:** I was an English teacher.



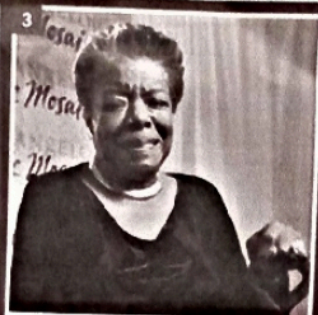

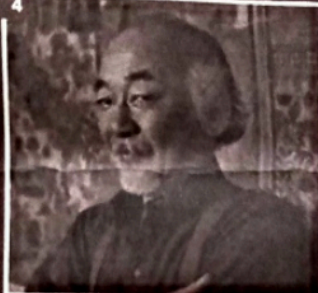
