**Mindy:** What was the job?

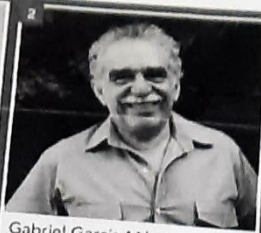
**Alan:** I was an English teacher.
