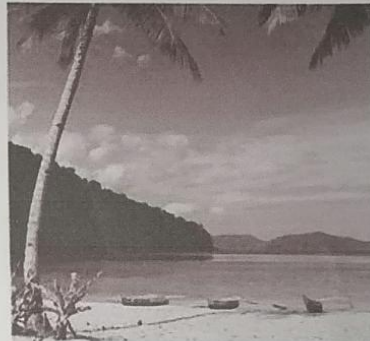

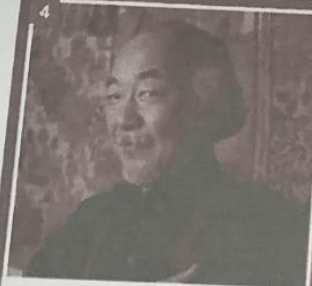
1 Marie Curie, scientist (1867–1934)
