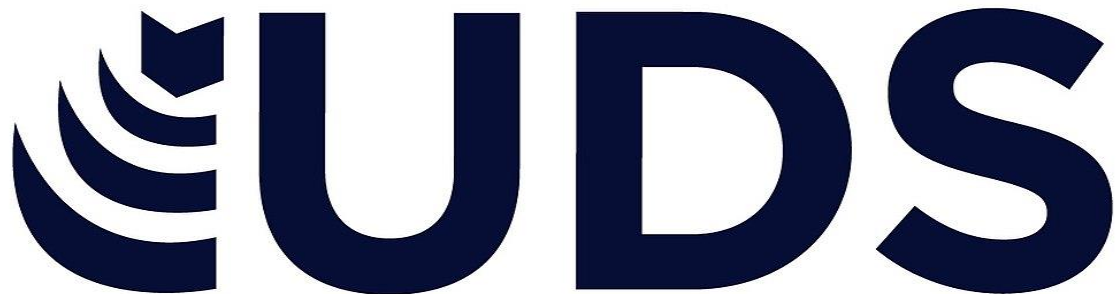

THE SIMPLE PRESENT Gabino Gabriel

Positive statements – verbs with special forms

With he / she / it (3rd person) the following verbs have a special form in the Simple Present:

Verbs ending in
- O, - CH, - SH, - SS, - X, - Z

We add -ES

- I switch \Rightarrow He switches
- We kiss \Rightarrow She kisses

Verbs ending in
a consonant + Y

We add -IES

- I try \Rightarrow She tries
- We carry \Rightarrow He carries



NOTE:

For verbs ending with a vowel + Y, we just add -S.

- play – plays
- enjoy – enjoys
- say – says

- q) dream: My friend often dreams about money, but I dream about holidays.
