

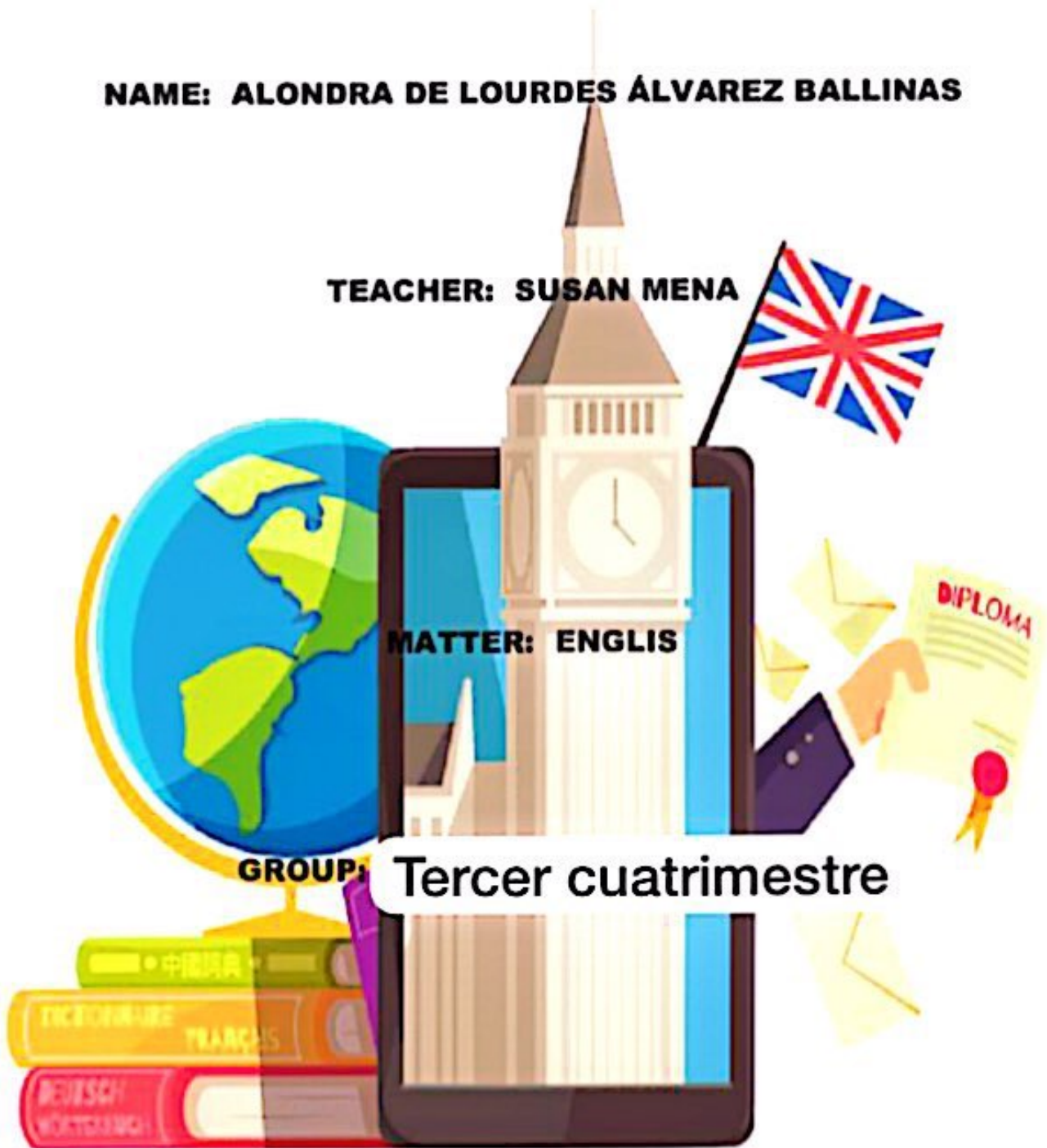

Positive statements – verbs with special forms

With **he / she / it** (3rd person) the following verbs have a special form in the Simple Present:

Verbs ending in

- O, - CH, - SH, - SS, - X, - Z

We add **-ES**

- I switch → He switches
- We kiss → She kisses

Verbs ending in
a consonant + Y

We add **-IES**

- I try → She tries
- We carry → He carries



NOTE:

For verbs ending with a vowel + Y, we just add **-S**.

- play – plays
- enjoy – enjoys
- say – says
