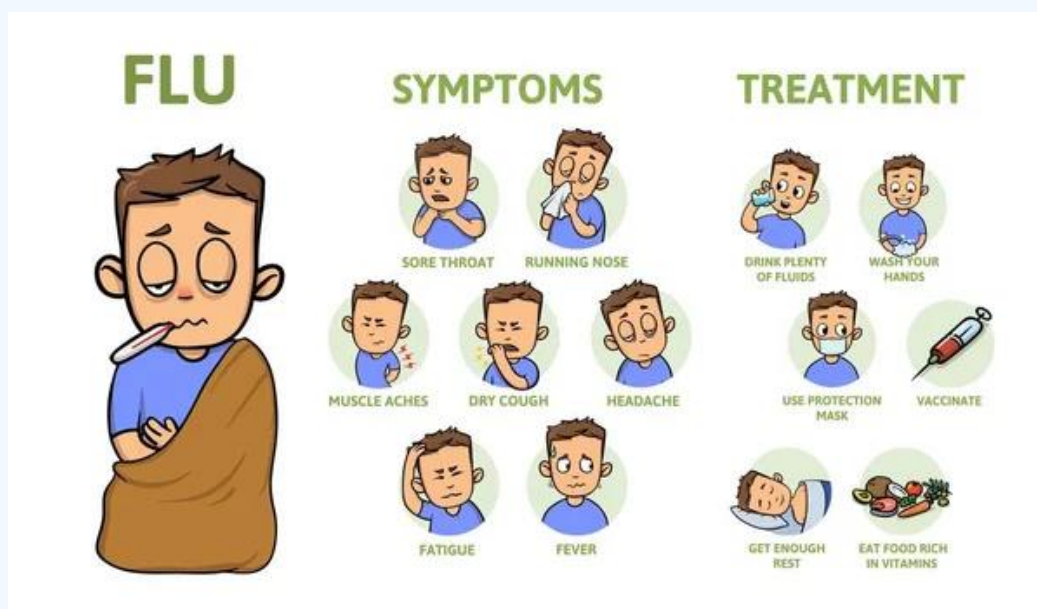

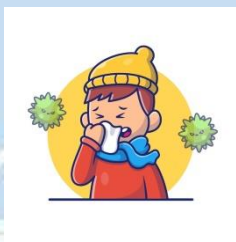

symptoms

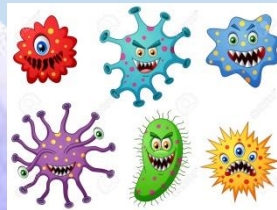
- common cold with runny nose

Flu

causative pathogens

There are four types of seasonal flu viruses: A, B, C and D. Seasonal epidemics are caused by type A and B influenza viruses.



This term is normally used to describe microorganisms such as viruses, bacteria and fungi, among others.

Diagnostic

The diagnosis of influenza is carried out by clinical history and physical examination. The flu is caused by a group of viruses called the flu or influenza viruses, of which there are three types A, B, and C.



Treatment

A pain reliever: usually paracetamol, acetylsalicylic acid or ibuprofen. **An antitussive:** dextromethorphan. **An antihistamine:** chlorphenamine.
