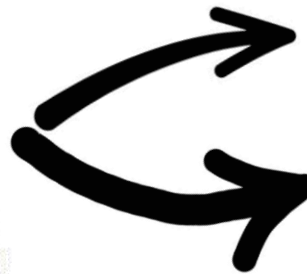

Definition

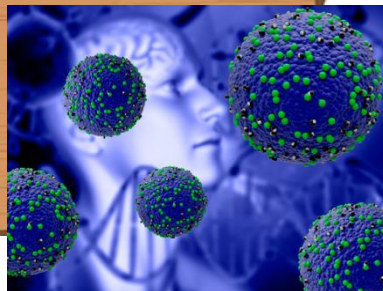
Measles is a disease caused by a virus that is found in the nose and throat of a child or adult.

it is usually transmitted through direct contact and through the air. The virus infects the respiratory tract and spreads to the rest of the body. It is a human disease that does not affect animals.



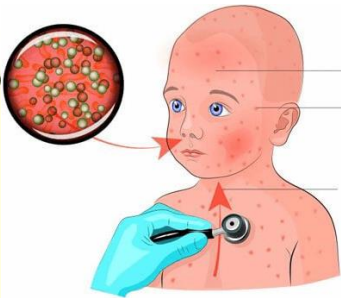
Symtoms
