An important challenge for veterinary medicine is to adequately address the diversity of animal species. Veterinarians address the health needs of domestic animals, including cats, dogs, chickens, horses, cows, sheep, pigs and goats; wildlife; Animal zoo; pet birds; and ornamental fish. The sizes of the animals that are treated vary from newborn hamsters to adult elephants, as do their economic values, which range from the indefinable value of the companionship of a pet to the high monetary value of a Winning racehorse. The medication of this variety of domesticated and wild animals requires knowledge and skills.

Based on recognition by the World Health Organization (WHO) or the government of a country, there are around 450 veterinary degree programs around the world. Academic veterinarians administer the basic and clinical science programs of veterinary schools.

Additionally, they conduct basic and clinical research, the latter of which may involve the application of
