This wide range of activities in which the Veterinary Doctor affects is of great importance for the development of countries, and has a direct impact on the population, so much so that the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) and the World Association of Veterinarians (AMV) have issued a statement in which they remind that the activities carried out by veterinary doctors should be considered essential to guarantee food safety, prevent diseases and manage emergencies.

The importance that animals have in people's lives has been increasing more and more over the years, not only within the agricultural sector, but also in domestic life. In the current situation, the development of the Veterinary Doctor in Public Health is crucial mainly in specific activities such as: Prevention, control and elimination of zoonoses, Prevention and control of animal health problems of social and economic importance, Safety and quality of foods of animal origin, Promotion and support of actions that favor national and international tourism as well as trade and livestock exchange within and outside the borders, Investigation of outbreaks of foodborne illnesses, Research early detection prevention and control of exotic animal diseases emerging zoonoses and biological threats. In carrying out their work, veterinarians have a responsibility to safeguard their health, the health of those they work with, and the health of their clients. They must therefore ensure that adequate levels of biosecurity are applied, that their staff are protected with the necessary equipment and that animal owners are informed of the precautionary measures applied.
