Common name: Mexican Ajolote
 Scientific name: *Ambystoma mexicanum*
 Habitat: Aquatic
 Food: molluscs, worms, larvae, crustaceans.
 Reproduction: They lay up to 5,000 eggs
 Situation: **In critical danger** ⚠️

Common name: Vaquita marina
 Scientific name: *Phocoena sinus*
 Habitat: Gulf of California
 Food: fish, squid and plankton
 Reproduction: Gestation of 10-11 months giving a single offspring.
 Situation: **In critical danger** ⚠️

Common name: Totoaba
 Scientific name: *Totoaba macdonaldi*
 Habitat: Gulf of California
 Food: crabs, shrimp, sardines and other small fish.
 Reproduction: 2-7 pups in their entire life
 Situation: **In critical danger** ⚠️

Common name: Teporingo
 Scientific name: *Romerolagus diazi*
 Habitat: volcanoes of the Valley of Mexico
 Food: grasses, tree leaves and young plants.
 Reproduction: by birth of 1-3 offspring.
 Situation: **In danger of extinction** ☹️

Common name: Yucatecan Sardinilla
 Scientific name: *Fundulus persimilis*
 Habitat: Sweet to brackish waters
 Food: plankton, crustaceans and eggs of other species
 Reproduction: Between 50 thousand-60 thousand eggs
 Situation: **Danger of extinction** ☹️

Common name: Chara naana
 Scientific name: *Cyanolyca nanus*
 Habitat: subtropical or tropical humid mountain forests.
 Food: insects and they get nuts and seeds from trees
 Reproduction: speaker 2-3 eggs
 Situation: **Danger of extinction** ☹️

Common name: Tehuantepec Hare
 Scientific name: *Lepus flavigularis*
 Habitat: southeast of Oaxaca
 Food: pastures, herbs and shrubs.
 Reproduction: 2 leatros 32 days after copulation.
 Situation: **In danger of extinction** ☹️

Common name: Mono saraguato
 Scientific name: *Alouatta*
 Habitat: Territories of Veracruz, Chiapas, Oaxaca and Campeche
 Food: Leaves, sprouts and fruits.
 Reproduction: 2 offspring each period
 Situation: **In danger of extinction** ☹️

Common name: Tapir
 Scientific name: *Tapirus bairdii*
 Habitat: Southeast of Chiapas
 Food: leaves, fruits, seeds and bark of herbs, shrubs and trees.
 Reproduction: 1 calf every two years
 Situation: **Danger of extinction** ☹️

Common name: White-tailed deer
 Scientific name: *Odocoileus virginianus*
 Habitat: area of mountains
 Food: green grasses and herbs
 Reproduction: 1-3 offspring per period
 Situation: **danger of extinction** ☹️
