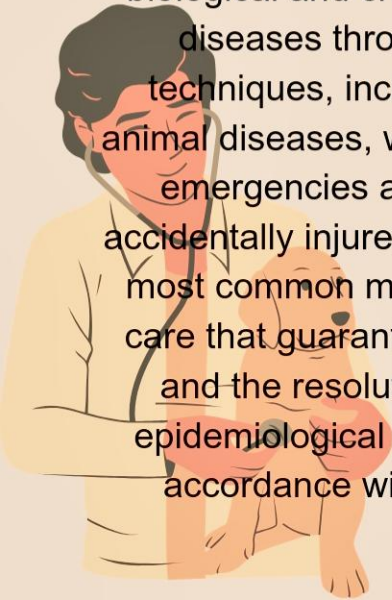

Veterinary medicine is the application of medicine to animals. It deals with the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of diseases, disorders and injuries in animals. Anyone who becomes a specialist in this discipline is known as a veterinary doctor, zootechnical veterinary doctor or veterinary surgeon, veterinary doctor, in feminine form. The scope of veterinary medicine is broad, and covers all species, both domestic and wild. It studies the physiological characteristics of animals, as well as the diseases that affect them, their treatment and prevention through the eradication of parasites and infections and the use of technological and scientific advances. diagnose, predict, treat and prevent diseases that affect domestic, experimental, exotic, wild and livestock animals. Furthermore, this professional is no longer restricted only to the area of animal health but has a broader field, and can work in the study, diagnosis and treatment of animal diseases that affect people. The veterinarian can work in a veterinary practice on his or her own or as an independent contractor, treating domestic animals, normally in urban areas; or you can work by traveling to the client's location: farms, agri-food industries, private homes, etc. Performs clinical examination of animals and prepares their clinical history. Collects and sends all types of samples with their corresponding report. Applies basic analytical techniques and interprets clinical, biological and chemical results. Diagnoses the most common animal diseases through the use of different general and instrumental techniques, including necropsy. Identifies, controls and eradicates animal diseases, with special attention to notifiable diseases. Attends to emergencies and Performs veterinary first aid when an animal is accidentally injured and requires urgent medical attention. Performs the most common medical-surgical treatments on animals. Applies basic care that guarantees the correct functioning of the reproductive cycle and the resolution of obstetric problems. Advises and carries out epidemiological studies and therapeutic and preventive programs in accordance with animal welfare, animal health and public health standards.
