PAST SIMPLE

AFIRMATIVES

Structure: Subject + verb (past simple) + complement.

1. I ran in the street this morning.
2. You walked in the park with your son.
3. He awoke too late yesterday.
4. She cooked the dinner last night
5. We slept in the bed.

NEGATIVES

Structure: Subject + didn't + infinitive verb + complement.

1. I didn't build the family factory.
2. We didn't eat in the mall the last week.
3. It didn't work very fast in the job.
4. He didn't climb the volcan chichonal.
5. You didn't read the notes.

INTERROGATIVES

Structure, Question: Did + subject + infinitive verb + complement + ?.

Structure, Answer: Yes, + Subject + did.

Structure, Answer: No, + Subject + did + not/n't

1. Did they write the class notes today? No, they didn't.
2. Did she search a trainer this afternoon? Yes, she did.
3. Did you listen the song yesterday? No, I didn't.
4. Did my friend help me with my homework? Yes, he did.
5. Did we play "Freefire" the last weekend? No, we didn't.
