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## DESCRIBING MY TOWN

The town where I live is called Motozintla or also known as "Ladera de ardillas", it is part of the Sierra Madre de Chiapas, it has approximately 75 thousand inhabitants. It could be said that it is medium in terms of territory and infrastructure; You can see the surrounding mountains, with different types of flora and fauna. In this area the native or mother tongue is called Mocho, and there are currently few speakers of the language.

In it there is a sports unit better known as copal stadium, where different activities have been carried out, such as soccer tournaments (from different areas), school activities, previously the cultural and sports fair that took place in March was held there. In the central municipal park, different activities are also carried out, such as the patron saint fair that takes place in October, they also make religious programs, clowns, schools or the house of culture.

The most important celebration of the mochós is that of the patron saint of the town San Francisco, which takes place from October 4 with a duration of three days; Those involved in the preparations for this commemoration are those with specific positions and of a lifetime nature. Where, by tradition, women make the preparation of puzunque, which is a traditional drink of a ceremonial and ritual nature. The puzunque consists of a mixture of wheat flour with ginger, anise, pepper, chili, cocoa and pericón; It is taken during the feast. The puzunque is offered to San Francisco.
