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Frontera Comalapa, is recently considered as a city, but at the time it was also a town, the term Comalapa is called that way since it comes from the Nahuatl word: Comalapan In the water of the comales, that is the term with which it is able to determine, the number of inhabitants varies as the years go by.

The city lacks theaters, museums, concert halls. It has a house of culture, where guitar, marimba, dance, drawing and painting classes are taught. Although in the community there is a Mi Bodega Aurrera supermarket and a Coppel department store, among other chains of national origin such as: Elektra, Milano, Telas parisina among others, it has small shops and markets, the people in this place are humble of heart and hardworking people, there is also a variety of small and large pharmacies, which are, savings pharmacies, similar pharmacy, Yireth pharmacy, central pharmacy, are the most recognized.

Within education there are a variety of schools, from kindergarten, primary, secondary, telesecondary, high school, cobach and cetis, talking about the dominant religion Christianity, and within it, the Catholic Church, is the church that can be found in the central park.

The climate that is recorded throughout the territory of Frontera Comalapa is warm subhumid with rains in summer, it has an intense vegetation, most people are dedicated to agriculture, a great variety of fruit trees in seasons such as tamarind, Papaya, coconut, chili, pumpkin, passion fruit, pear, jocote, mango, bananas, oranges, corn, what most characterizes is the harvest of coffee and corn.
