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Sintomas

Rubella: In many countries, rubella infection is rare or even non-existent.

ARE

Tos: Coughin is a reflex that keeps the throat and airways clear.

Measle: Measle causes a red, blotchy rash that usually appears first on the face and behind the ears, then spreads down to the chest and back, and finally to the feet.

Swollen glands: They help the body recognize and fight microbes, infection and other foreign substances.

Fever: fever is a temporary increase in body temperature.

Sore throat: You can have a sore throat for several reasons. Often the cause is a cold and flu.

Headache: Serious causes of headaches are rare.

Mumps: They are a contagious disease that causes a painful inflammation of the salivary glands, which produce saliva, a liquid that moistens food and helps one chew and swallow.

Runny nose: It happens when excess fluid flows through the nose.

Nausea: They present as a situation of discomfort in the upper part of the stomach

Rash: Skin rashes involve changes in color of your skin.

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
