Assessing common childhood diseases

Rubella

is a contagious viral disease that occurs most often in children.

Origin of infecton

The rubella virus is transmitted by airborne droplets when infected people sneeze or cough.

Symptoms

- Low fever
- Headache
- cough
- Runny nose

- conjunctivitis
- Swollen or enlarged lymph nodes

Treatment

There is no specific medication to treat rubella or make the disease go away faster.

Measles

is a very contagious and serious disease

Origin of infecton

It is caused by a virus from the paramyxovirus family and is usually transmitted through direct contact and through the air.

Symptoms

high fevercoughrunny nose (rhinitis)red and watery eyes

Treatment

There is no specific treatment for measles, and most patients recover within 2 to 3 weeks.

Mumps

they are a contagious disease that causes inflammation.

Origin of infecton

are caused by a virus

Symptoms

swollen and tender cheeks and jaw

Fever
loss of appetite
fatigue

Treatment

Taking over-the-counter pain relievers, such as ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin IB, and others) and acetaminophen (Tylenol, and others)
