Anatomy

Anatomy is a science, branch of biology, that studies the structure of living beings, that is, the shape, topography, location, arrangement and relationship between each other of the organs that compose it.

Identify pathologies that affect multiple organs or organ systems. Which can facilitate early diagnosis and treatment of diseases

Biology

It is the natural science that studies everything related to life and the organic, including the processes, systems, functions, mechanisms or other biological characteristics underlying living beings in various specialized fields.

Microbiology

Microbiology is the science in charge of the study and analysis of microorganisms, tiny living beings not visible to the human eye, also known as microbes.

Parasitology

pharmacology

The basic objective of pharmacology for nursing is to improve patient care by promoting the use of drugs in a safe and effective way, also having a very important role in educating the user and sometimes even the family members. on drug administration and rational consumption.

Bioéthcs

It is the branch of applied ethics that reflects, deliberates and makes normative and public policy approaches to regulate and resolve conflicts in social life, especially in the life sciences, as well as in medical practice and research that affect the life on the planet, both today and in future generations.
