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**Nursing and its relationship with other sciences.**

**Biology**

**What is it?**

Branch of science that is dedicated to the study of living beings or organisms.

**Relationship**

Among the basic knowledge of the two nurses are the disciplines of the area of biology.

**Function**

Improve the quality of care. moral and ethical values of respect and dignity for human beings

**Medicine**

**What is it?**

Science that studies diseases that affect humans, prevention and treatment to cure them.

**Relationship**

Doctor provides knowledge about the patient's illness to the nurse.

**Function**

Sample taking, hygiene, hospital, legionella control.

**Psychology**

**What is it?**

Science that studies the sensational mental processes, perceptions and behavior of human beings.

**Relationship**

Understanding the human mind and behavior helps nurses connect with patients.

**Function**

Regulate the transmission of information by nursing so that it adjusts to the rhythm.

**Anthropology**

**What is it?**

Science that studies physical aspects and social and cultural manifestations of all human communities

**Relationship**

It can enrich anthropological practice and theory. Enabling health information to the body.

**Function**

It provides the nursing discipline with the necessary keys to address sociocultural situations.

**Toxicology.**

**What is it?**

Part of medicine that deals with the study and effects of toxic or poisonous products on the body.

**Relationship**

Due to the adverse health effects caused by chemical agents

**Function**

It deals with the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of poisoning in humans and animals.

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
