Rubella

It is a contagious viral infection that mainly affects children and young adults.

origin

infectious disease caused by a virus.

Symptoms

- fever level of 102 °F (38,9 °C)
- nasal congestion
- headache
- red eyes
- red rash, or enlarged lymph nodes in the neck

Treatment

While there is no treatment to clear an established infection, medications can counteract the symptoms. Vaccination can help prevent the disease.

Measles

It is a very contagious viral disease.

origin

The disease spreads rapidly through the air through small droplets of saliva when coughing or sneezing, it is caused by a virus.

Symptoms

- cough
- runny nose
- swollen eyes
- sore throat
- fever
- blotchy red rash on the skin.

Treatment

There is no specific treatment or therapy for measles. Most measles patients recover with rest and supportive treatment, and for severely ill patients, treatment is given based on complications.

Mumps

affects the glands on either side of the face

Origin

Viral disease caused by paramyxovirus, this virus initially penetrates and multiplies in the cells of the respiratory system and is then transported by the blood to all tissues.

Symptoms

- chills
- fatigue
- fever
- malaise
- loss of appetite dry mouth
- headache
- swollen lymph nodes
- neck swelling
- swollen salivary glands, or hearing loss

Treatment

Take pain relievers that can be purchased without a prescription. Apply a cold or warm cloth to the swollen salivary glands.
