Too

is an adverb that indicates that there is more than enough.

Ejemplo:

She has too many friends.

Enough

Sufficient, and is always placed after adjectives.

Ejemplo:

-I don't have enough time.

Would like

It is an auxiliary, that is, it does not have a complete meaning on its own.

Ejemplo:

If it doesn't rain tomorrow, I would like to go stargazing.

# Topic 4.

## 4.8: the past tense of be.

The past tense of be is was or were. What is the difference between was and were? It depends on the subject (or who is talking).

### Example sentences with was

- The boy was tired.
- I was busy when you called me.
- How was your date?

### Example sentences with were

- They were happy.
- We were for the test.
- Why were you angry?

- I was / He was / she was / it was
- We were / You were / They were.

## 4.1 The past simple structure of the sentences with irregular verbs.

There are a few hundred irregular verbs with different forms.

Positive sentences: S + irregular verb (ed).  
Example: She worked yesterday.

Negative sentences: S + did not + verb (base form).  
Example: She didn't work yesterday.

Interrogative sentences: Did + S + verb (in base form)?  
Example: Did she work yesterday?

## 4.2 Describe your past activities.

- + She went to bed early.
- Yesterday I went for a run.
- We didn't like onions.
- I didn't go to work yesterday.
- ? Did she play basket ball.
- Exercised on Monday.
