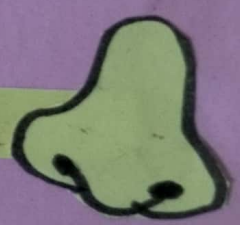

How is our body?

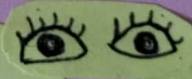


My Body parts.

Interrogative ?

can + subject + complement.

- She can cook?
- they can't run in the desert?

- He can dance?
- I can't fly around the world?

Negative -
M.V.
subject + can't + complement

- He can not swim
- He can't dance.

- She can't cook
- they can't run in the desert.
