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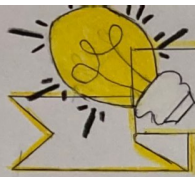

ADJECTIVES TO DESCRIBE HAIR

Words that qualify a person or thing

Examples:

- She has straight hair
- He has black hair and dreadlocks.
- I have a bun in my hair
- They have red and wavy hair
- We have a nephew who has shaved head hair.
- Your hair has a beautiful beard.

APPEARANCE

How we see or perceive people or things.

Examples:

- My daughter is tall and has brown eyes.
- I have an oval face and black hair.
- He has a moustache on his face.
- She has blue eyes
- My brother is fat
- My grandmother is young.

PARTS OF THE BODY

How is our body?

Examples:

- My mother has long legs
- She has green eyes
- He has big lips
- They have long necks
- My daughter has a round forehead
- I have thin arms

- My sister has a rash
- I have blisters in my hand
