Demasiado Enough Suficiente

too = more than what is needed.  
Enough = sufficient; as much as needed.

too + adjective  
• This tea is too hot, I can't drink it.

too + adverb  
• He drives too fast. It's dangerous.

adjective + enough  
• He is tall enough to reach the top shelf.

adverb + enough  
• I am fast enough to run with her.

would like  
expresar deseo

+ subject + would like + to + Verb base form  
I would like to go on vacation

- Subject + would not like + to + Verb base form  
She wouldn't like an expensive bag

? would + subject + like + to + Verb base form  
would you like to go swimming?

Past Simple Structure

+ Subject + Verb in past + Complement  
Eddy worked yesterday

- Subject + Did + Not + infinitive Verb  
Eddy didn't work yesterday.

? Did + Subject + infinitive Verb + Complement?  
Did Eddy work yesterday?
