#### Affirmative

##### Examples:

- There was a concert last night.
- There were movies last weekend.
- There was a marathon last Friday.



#### Negative

##### Examples:


- You weren't home last Monday.
- She wasn't home yesterday.
- I wasn't doing my home work.



#### Affirmative

##### Examples:

- I went to the grocery store yesterday.
- She danced all night at the party.
- He ate a sandwich for lunch.



#### Negative

##### Examples:


- She didn't study Spanish in college.
- He didn't eat a sandwich for lunch.
- We didn't watch a movie at the cinema.

### 4.2 The past simple tense.

#### Affirmative

##### Examples:

- She liked the movie.
- I liked the flowers.
- He liked to sing.

##### Examples:

- You didn't like the concert.
- I didn't like the flowers.
- He didn't like the movie.
