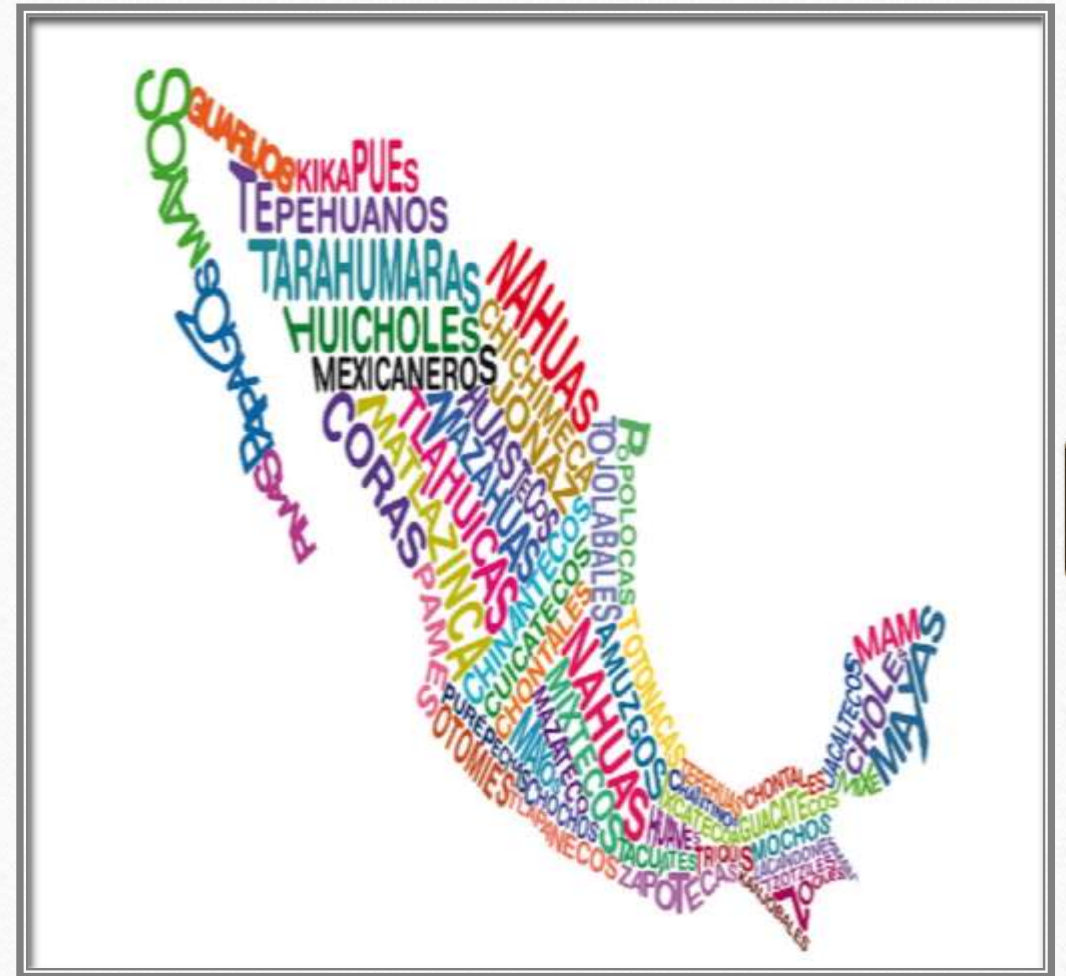

MEXICAN NATIONALITY

Any person born in Mexican territory has Mexican nationality, regardless of the nationality of his or her father or mother; persons born abroad daughters of a Mexican father or Mexican mother (or both Mexican ancestors) and persons born abroad daughters of a Mexican father by naturalization or Mexican mother by naturalization (or both persons of Mexican ancestry by naturalization).



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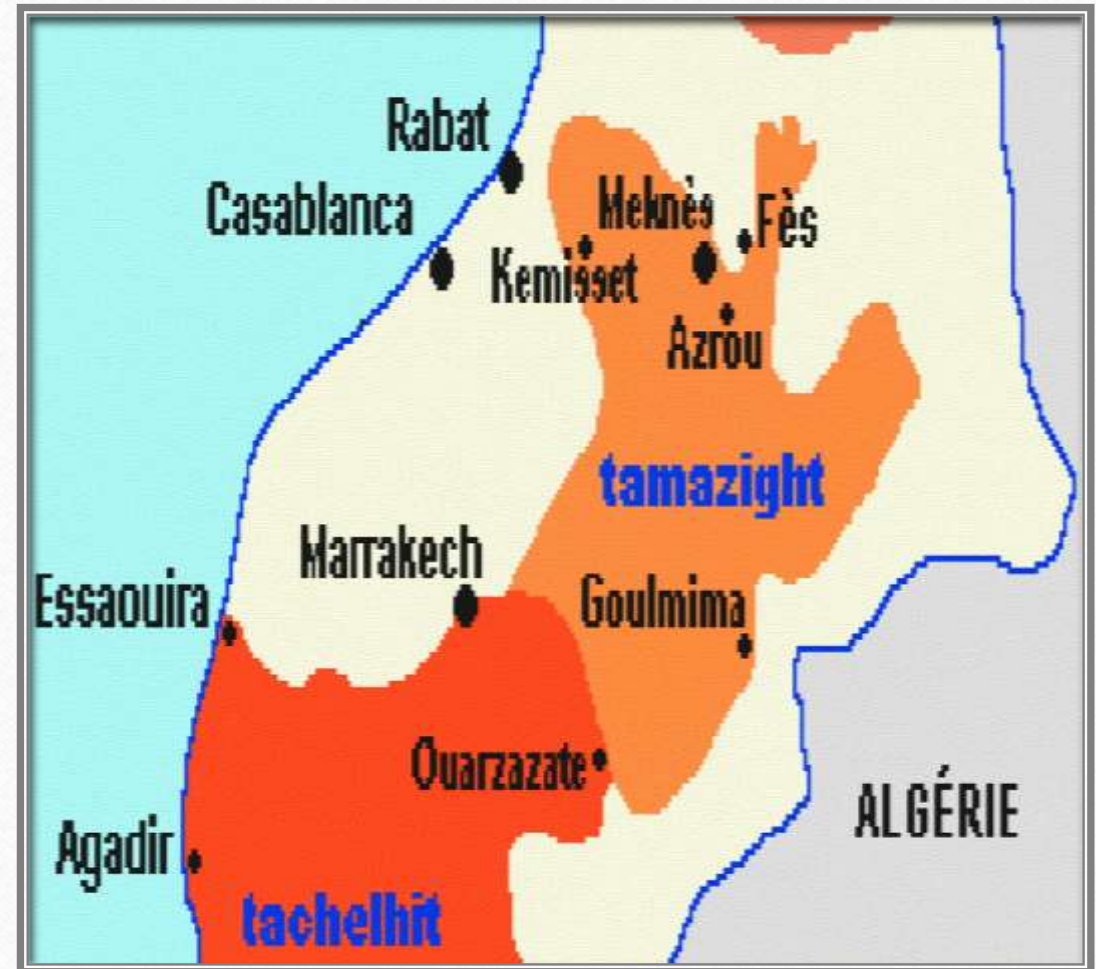

MOROCCAN LANGUAGE

In general terms, the language spoken by the majority of the population is Moroccan Arabic, little by little influenced by the so-called classical Arabic. However, it is most common for the population to speak two or three languages, due to the linguistic diversity within the same territory.



MOROCCAN CLOTHING

The traditional clothing of men and women is called djellaba; This is a loose-fitting tunic with a hood. For special occasions, men also wear a red hat called a tarbush, better known as a Fez. Almost all men wear slippers, shoes, usually yellow.
