Shashlyk: Dish prepared with meat and onion.

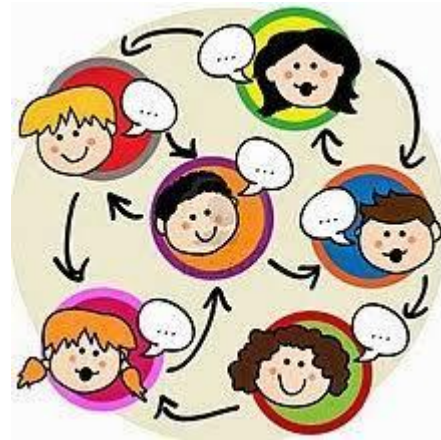
Ajiaco, Casabe, Buñuelos, Tamales, Tostones, Roasted Pork and Congrí.

The sarafan is a traditional Russian women's garment. It is a long, sleeveless dress with a trapezoidal line, with straps.

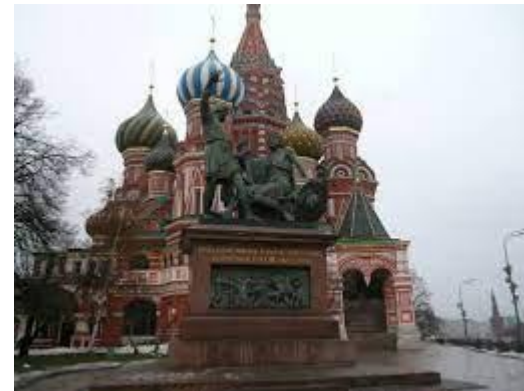
the guayabera, considered in Cuba as a piece of both gala and common use; the cuban robe
