# GRAMMAR The Past Simple tense

 We use the Past Simple to talk about completed actions or situations that took place at a specific time in the past.

Example: I visited Berlin last week.

Example: Andrew watched TV yesterday.

Sometimes the speaker may not mention the specific time, but they do have a specific time in mind.
 Example: When I went to Japan I enjoyed it a lot.

### Regular verbs

Affirmative		Negative	Questions

#### Spelling changes

- Regular verbs add -ed to the base form.

Example: watch-watched

- If the base form ends in "e", just add -d.

Example: like-liked

- If the base form ends in a consonant + "y", add -ied.

Example: study- studied

If the base form ends in a vowel + "y", odd -ed.

Example: play-palyed

If the base form ends in a consonant after a stressed vowel at the end of the word, double the
consonant and add -ed.

Example: stop-stopped

#### Irregular verbs

Some verbs have an irregular form for the Past Simple. There is no rule for these verbs. You should learn them by heart.

Here are some examples.

come -	came	get →	got	say -	said
cut -	cut	90 →	went	see -	saw
