GRAMMAR The Past Simple tense

 We use the Past Simple to talk about completed actions or situations that took place at a specific time in the past.

Example: I visited Berlin last week.

Example: Andrew watched TV yesterday.

- Sometimes the speaker may not mention the specific time, but they do have a specific time in mind. Example: When I went to Japan I enjoyed it a lot.

Spelling changes

Regular verbs add –ed to the base form.
 Example: watch-watched

- If the base form ends in "e", just add -d.

Example: like-liked

If the base form ends in a consonant + "y", add -ied.
 Example: study- studied

If the base form ends in a vowel + "y", add -ed.
 Example: play- palyed

- If the base form ends in a consonant after a stressed vowel at the end of the word, double the consonant and add -ed.

Example: stop-stopped

Irregular verbs

Some verbs have an irregular form for the Past Simple. There is no rule for these verbs. You should learn them by heart.

Here are some examples.

cut -	cut	go .	→ went	see → saw




