Pronoun Conjugation

Pronouns replace subjects, they are not useful when we do not know the name and when we do not want to sound repetitive

Conjugation: *am, is, are*

Structure in positive, negative, and interrogative forms

Helps us to specify the way our sentence sounds, i.e. when we mention something we understand whether it is positive, negative and interrogative

(+) (-) (?)

Negative contractions

In English it helps us that the word allows us to emphasize the idea of negation in the phrase

Not

¿How do I apply it?

I-am
You-are
He-is
She-is
It-is
We-are
You-are
They-are

I am a teacher

He is in the park

¿How do I apply it?

Positive: Subject + Verbo to be + Complement
Negative: Subject + Verbo to be + Not + Complement
Interrogative: Verbo to be + Subject + Complement + ?

You are happy

You are not happy

Are you happy?

¿How do I apply it?

No contracted

Pron + Verb

Verb to be + not

We are not

We're not

We aren't
